But often people feel that it is too ingrained in our modern world to change.


Yet, as a Christian community we have a moral duty to care for the earth and all living things. Pope Francis said it quite clearly:



They also might visit stay-at-home moms who long for adult conversation. Friendly Visitors do not relieve professional caregivers. 


