THIS IS US...

The G.I.F.T. Program is welcoming registrations from households with members ages 6 and older– including single adults, couples, empty nesters. G.I.F.T. has members who are in their 60', 70's and 80's! This unique whole-community model serves families with children and adults at every stage of life.

Archbishop Blair sent a letter to all pastors encouraging a change in traditional child-centered catechetical models, "It is the time for us to reexamine the models of faith formation currently in use and adopt innovative ways of forming families... We have always presumed catechesis when what is often needed today is far more basic; namely, the kerygma, the foundational proclamation of the gospel message inviting people to believe not just with the head but the heart through an encounter with Christ." Fortunately, for Midd-South Catholic, intergenerational, life-long learning has been in place since 2005 and continues to be the primary form of family and adult faith-formation in our parish. All current Church teaching, research and trends throughout the country reinforce that parents are the primary influence in the faith of their children. Our program seeks to support parents in this role while offering quality learning opportunities for adults and age appropriate instruction for children.

G.I.F.T. (Growing in Faith Together) follows a six-year cycle that incorporates the Catechism of the Catholic Church through six learning themes: Church Year, Sacraments, The Creed, Morality, Prayer and Catholic Social Teaching. This year's theme is Jesus Calling: Called to be followers of Christ. It will be the fourth time we are teaching this theme. We look forward to engaging our response to God's calling in our own lives, through exploring the the liturgical year and life in Christ. Many adults without children in the program comment how their knowledge and faith have grown through this experience. See comments from Larry and Sue Gannon who have been a part of the program since it began in 2005.

G.I.F.T. builds community, involves generations interacting together, and is done in six 2.5 hour monthly sessions. It begins with a meal, all-ages opening segment, grade level breakout student sessions and an adult session, and concludes with a quick all-ages closing. There is a discounted fee of \$60 for those ages 60 and older. - Our program is open to single adults and families! All new students must provide any Sacramental certificate copies to the Registrations.




