Come Home to Fellowship, Community, Growth!

At Pentecost, the disciples gathered "in one place together." (Acts 2:1) After walking with Jesus, breaking bread with him and with one another, this tight-knit group had formed a life-giving community. Who was this little community? Well, Mary, Jesus' very first disciple, was there, along with other women and men—some whose names we know. Not as individuals but together as a group, they prayed, hoped, and waited. Together they experienced an amazing transformation in the power of the Holy Spirit, becoming a community fully alive and ready to embark on the great mission to which Jesus called them.


Today, we are the ones who, coming together, become the evangelizing community that the Spirit is forming and empowering. And have you noticed that, little by little, our community is growing. We are adding to our numbers, just as happened in the first century. Nancy Cirincione (in white blazer), one of our newest companions in faith, tells us, "I truly feel at home and at peace here at Midd-South Catholic Parish." Over several months, Nancy walked with a group of seekers, praying and learning in common following a process called the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA). This process is designed to help create the feeling that Nancy describes. Jennifer Voity (in floral dress) agrees. "I have formed a forever bond with this small group of men and women. I am so grateful to have had this experience!"

Beginning wherever they find themselves in their journey of faith, OCIA participants gather with sponsor-friends and catechists to walk side-by-side, learning and growing as they connect with God and the church in powerful ways—just like the community of disciples described in the New Testament. "As I learned and understood the teachings of the Catholic Church," explains new Catholic, Ron Sanctuary (tan jacket), "I know it has deepened my faith in so many ways. I have a more powerful sense of God's presence in my life than I ever have before."

Maybe you or someone you know is ready to gather with us more deeply in faith and fellowship. The Midd-South Catholic OCIA group meets year-round, so you can join in whenever you want. Together we walk at a comfortable pace as we together discern the path where God is leading us.

G.I.F.T: A two-way street

It was about twenty years ago now that our intergenerational faith formation program, what would soon become what we know now as GIFT, was in the earliest stages of being developed. I was so excited I had to tell anyone who would listen. I remember saying to three other women who were with me in a small study group, "Just think of how much you will have to share with other folks in this program!" No one argued with me, but I was met with blank expressions, looks of disbelief. I was thinking of the years of life-experiences, lives of deep faith that they could offer as incentive and support to anyone participating in the programs to come. Sitting at table together would be only a start.

What seemed so hard to swallow way back then has turned out to be the blessed reality of these years of our GIFT program. And not surprisingly, it has been a two-way street: along with the generous sharing that so many are willing to do, has come the increase in learning that undergirds our faith, enriching our lives and giving depth to our own prayer-life and our worship as a family of faith. It has opened our eyes to opportunities to offer wholehearted service beyond the confines of our own small lives, and to receive gratefully what others, young and old have to offer. *-Maureen McDermott*

- Our program is open to single adults and families! All new students must provide any Sacramental certificate copies to the Registrations.


