THIS IS US...

All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age (Matt. 28:18-20).

Are you a disciple who makes disciples?



This question is central to our learning theme in GIFT this year where we will explore Jesus' plan to spread God's Kingdom throughout the world, and how you and I have a part to play in it. Just as His first followers did by taking their disciples through the same basic teaching and training that Jesus had given them.

Making disciples is the great mission Jesus gave His followers before He returned to heaven. This mission, which has been passed down from generation to generation, now rests upon each one of us. If you need a little motivation for growing in your faith or sharing your faith with others GIFT may be what you need. Our learning topics will incorporate calling, discipleship, and the liturgical year in effort for us to follow his teachings and observe all that he commanded. The Growing in Faith Together program is for adults of every age and for households with children starting at age 6. There are six engaging monthly sessions (see schedule on next page) which begin with a meal, offer an all ages together opening and closing and age level break-out sessions. We welcome Fr.
